**DAILY REPORT ON ACTION TAKEN IN THE AFTERMATH OF CYCLONE
“PHAILIN” IN ODISHA AND FLOOD**

1. 4393 animals (Large Animal- 1487 Small Animals-2906) died in 13 districts as reported so far. 166579 poultry birds have also died in 5 districts. In Poultry Layer firm with 1 lakh birds near Chhatrapur in Govindpur Village have died.
2. 260 teams with 260 Veterinary Doctors and 767 Livestock Inspectors have been put in place in affected Districts to provide medicines and vaccines to animals wherever necessary. Such vaccinations have been completed earlier as there was a flood warning in August, 2013.
3. Vaccines and medicines are available in the field level.
4. 627.250 MTs of cattle feed has been dispatched to 61 locations. 217 MTs of cattle feed have been distributed in the following districts;
 - i) Ganjam – 71 MT
 - ii) Kendrapada- 10 MT
 - iii) Khordha- 43 MT
 - iv) Puri - 26 MT
 - v) Jajpur - 30 MT
 - vi) Gajapati- 10 MT
 - vii) Balasore- 12 MT
 - viii) Bhadrak- 15 MT

The V.A.S., Seragada have been instructed by the Collector, Ganjam for distribution of rice & cash. The C.D.V.O. I/C. , Ganjam reported that the distribution of cattle feed can be effected only after normal relief is distributed in affected areas.

5. 13 (Thirteen) Mobile Veterinary Teams have been diverted to the affected districts (Ganjam- 05, Jagatsinghpur-02, Kendrapada-02, Jajpur-02, Bhadrak-02). 20 Veterinary Doctors from OUAT and 18 from other districts with 35 para-vets have been deployed in Ganjam for relief measures.

6. Carcasses of 1169 (1059 of Ganjam District) Large Animal, 2728(2645 of Ganjam District) Small animals & 1, 61,949 birds have been disposed off in 10 Cyclone affected Districts of the State.

50 ANANDMARGI workers were put on job for disposal of carcasses in Ganjam District. They have covered Chikiti & Digapahandi area. Dr. Jaladhar Mallick, Dy. Director (Fodder Dev.), Nodal Officer, CDVO, Ganjam and SDVOs are monitoring the relief measures and carcass disposal work. 2.7 MT of Bleaching Powder and 1.2 MT of lime have been sent to Ganjam district.

9. 174 Mobile Teams have been formed and till date 58720 animals/birds have been treated & 110600 animals have been vaccinated exclusive of above coverage.
10. From damage reports received from field the loss assessed is Rs.685.15 Lakhs relating to damage of 140 Veterinary Institutions in 8 (eight) districts.
